## DECLARATION OF THE EVANGELICALS OF CAMEROON REGARDING THE 2025 PRESIDENTIAL ELECTIONS

Sunday, October 12, 2025, marks a pivotal moment of democratic mobilization: the Cameroonian people are called upon to elect the person who will lead the nation for the next seven years. Given its significance, intensity, and impact, this presidential election carries exceptional gravity. On this occasion, the Alliance of Evangelicals of Cameroon (AEC), representing nearly 3,500 servants of God from the country's evangelical community, seeks to echo the expectations and aspirations of the more than seven (7) million individuals it encompasses.

Beyond political, partisan, social, and cultural contingencies, the AEC reaffirms the following:

- *“All authority comes from God, and the governing authority is a servant of God, established to administer justice according to His will.” (Romans 13:1)*
- *“The ruler is God’s servant for your good. But if you do wrong, be afraid, for he does not bear the sword in vain. He is God’s servant, an agent of wrath to bring punishment on the wrongdoer.” (Romans 13:4)*
- *“I urge, then, first of all, that petitions, prayers, intercession and thanksgiving be made for all people—for kings and all those in authority—that we may live peaceful and quiet lives in all godliness and holiness. This is good, and pleases God our Savior.” (1 Timothy 2:1-3)*

In the light of the above, we call upon all voters to turn out in large numbers and exercise their civic duty, bearing in mind the following considerations:

- **The President of the Republic**, as the cornerstone of our institutions, must demonstrably uphold the core values that ensure the security and well-being of the nation. He must stand as a bulwark against injustice, corruption, poverty, and social inequality, actively promote excellence and good governance, and serve as a catalyst for deep reform of the State and society in the supreme interest of the nation.
- **The President** must be a peacemaker and a unifier of all citizens, regardless of political affiliation, religion, ethnicity, or socio-cultural background. He must show a genuine commitment to restoring national unity and engage with fellow Africans in a spirit of pan-Africanism. He must be capable of restoring lasting peace, particularly in the Far North, Northwest, and Southwest regions.
- **The President** must lead Cameroon—this land of glory—toward genuine, multidimensional, and inclusive prosperity, in recognition of the abundant natural and demographic blessings that underpin its divine destiny.
- **The President** must uphold universal and biblical values of faith in God, the Supreme Holder of power, in his governance. This includes promoting biblical principles of family and firmly resisting moral, ethical, and societal deviations, notably LGBTQ+ practices, elective abortion without threat to the life of the pregnant woman, and facilitating marriage (exclusively between a man and a woman) following customary or religious ceremonies.
- **The President** must rely on Cameroonian religious institutions as sources of discernment in national decision-making. He should empower religious leaders and servants of God to have a voice in national forums, thereby guiding the nation's destiny with wisdom.

- **The President** must commit to restoring reverence for God within political and administrative circles, thereby eradicating corruption, favoritism, nepotism, tribalism, sectarianism, esotericism, and other harmful practices.
- **The President** must champion African independence and autonomy in the face of neocolonial and imperialist threats. The rise of Africa is the calling of this generation, as foretold in Isaiah 60:1-5. He must guarantee true political, economic, monetary, and financial self-determination for the continent.

In the face of a diverse political landscape, we urge voters to reflect deeply on the points outlined above when making their choice, while fervently praying that the entire electoral process unfolds in peace and tranquility, and that the nation's destiny is entrusted to the individual perfectly aligned with God's will.

May God bless our beloved and beautiful country, Cameroon.
